World Elder Abuse Awareness Day is commemorated each year on June 15<sup>th</sup>. Elder abuse is defined as any act that causes harm to an older person carried out by someone they know and trust. The abuse may take on various forms. Some of the most common examples are physical, emotional or sexual abuse, financial exploitation, neglect of basic needs or other forms of mistreatment. Personal Care Homes are often challenged with meeting the needs and expectations of residents and health care professionals. This presentation will examine the ethical and legal issues of elder abuse in an over-stressed and resource-challenged healthcare system.
